

BAM Nuttall avoid over 1.86 tonnes of CO2 by transitioning to the new Traffi LXT Range

Challenge:

When our client, BAM Nuttall, were faced with some issues recently in regards to their hand protection, OnSite Support worked with our supply chain partner, Traffi, to review their hand safety products.

BAM Nuttall had to comply with the minimum standards of cut C protection as requested by their client. However, they were finding the cut C gloves very cumbersome and restrictive, making general handling activities challenging. It was also identified that there was a trend of workers removing gloves to use devices as the current products provided weren't touchscreen compatible.

Impact:

Traffi recommended the TG6240 from their LXT range, due to its high cut resistance, dexterity, hard wearing coating and touchscreen capabilities. After trials had been carried out, it was clear that the TG6240 was the preferred glove of choice lasting double the time of the previous products, and the overall performance of the product being rated as excellent by staff.
