In order for us to achieve Gold we are asking our customers to look at and consider joining FORS Bronze and start the journey to more responsible fleet operations. Customers or contracted services who decide to join as FORS members will be monitored to ensure the FORS standard has been adopted, implemented and complied with and will then benefit and be able to publicly display the FORS accreditation.

Becoming a FORS member can bring you the peace of mind that your company is aware of and managing its work-related road risk (WRRR) – In addition it demonstrates to your customers & suppliers your commitment to exceeding the industry standard.
